Understanding the Ice Schedule

This Info Sheet is offered as an overview to assist in understanding the Ice Schedule. Questions related to the Ice Schedule can be directed to the Club office or a member of the Ice Committee.

Sessions are listed by test level designations (the free skate level a skater has passed determines which session they are eligible for). The levels that are listed first have priority for each session.

Free Skate Levels

- **NT** - No Test (skaters may have passed badges in group lessons, Basic 1-6 or Pre Free Skate-Free Skate 6 but have no formal testing thru U.S. Figure Skating)
- **PP** - Pre-Preliminary
- **Prel** - Preliminary
- **Pre-Juv** - Pre-Juvenile
- **Juv** - Juvenile
- **Int** - Intermediate
- **Nov** - Novice
- **Jr** - Junior
- **Sr** - Senior

Specialty Information

- **HP** - High Performance session where High Performance rules apply skater must be level appropriate
- **P1** - 1 pair team level appropriate to skate on these sessions
- **P1L** - 1 low level pair team up to juvenile to skate on these sessions
- **P2** - 2 pair teams level appropriate to skate on these sessions
- **D1** - 1 dance team level appropriate to skate on these sessions
- **D2** - 2 dance teams level appropriate to skate on these sessions
- **Free** - free skate session (it is not actually free of charge)
- **Free/Dance** - free skate and dance are allowed on these sessions if level appropriate
- **Pairs** – pairs are allowed on this session if level appropriate

Schedule Grid

White background –open to Club members and non-members, level appropriate, who are current members of U.S. Figure Skating and/or LearnToSkateUSA.

Gray background – open to full Club members only, level appropriate, who are current members of U.S. Figure Skating.

Examples

The test levels eligible for this 10:20 session (below) are: Senior to No Test free skate levels. This session allows free skate, dance, and up to 2 pair teams. This is also a High Performance session.

The priority for this session is: Senior to No Test, Club members.

The test levels eligible for the 6:50 session (below) are: Novice to Pre-Preliminary free skate levels. This session allows for free skate, 1 low level pair team. This session is open to full Club members only.
