Appendix D

Guidelines and Rules for Club Exhibitions

Any exceptions to these guidelines can only be made by Club management

Fall/Winter/Spring Exhibitions (Friday Nights, 30 skaters)
Summer Exhibitions (Wednesday/Thursday Afternoons, 18 skaters)

A typical exhibition will be limited between 18 and 30 performances. The limit may be increased from the beginning of the fall season through the start of the qualifying season. <u>Click here</u> to see the current Ice Schedules for exhibitions times.

- Sign-ups for Fall/Winter/Spring exhibitions will be accepted through the end
 of the day on Wednesday.
- Sign-ups for Summer exhibitions will be accepted through the end of the day on Monday.
- A stratified, random draw will determine the exhibition order, and follow a logical framework based on the number of performers and their competition levels/disciplines.
- Performers may not 'switch' or 'trade' their placements with other skaters in the exhibition order.
- The exhibition schedule will be posted by 12:00 PM on day prior to the scheduled exhibition.
- Skaters performing in upcoming international or qualifying competitions may be given skate priority.
- Skaters may only register for exhibitions 3 weeks in advance.

Priority will be determined by the following parameters, in descending order of importance:

- 1. Qualifying competitors
- 2. Number of performances in each period:
 - o Fall-Winter: September 1-January 31
 - o Spring: February 1-May 31
 - o Summer: June 1-August 31
- 3. Free Skate/Free Dance test level
- 4. Date of sign-up

^{*}If there is a wait list, skaters who had signed up and subsequently scratch after the close of business on the day preceding the exhibition will be assessed a \$25 cancellation fee to their Club account.
