(Preliminary Plus, Pre-Juvenile Plus, Juvenile Plus, Intermediate Plus, Novice, Junior, Senior)

- Qualifying skaters who earn a spot to compete in the Excel Final, will receive an invitation to register for the Excel Final via email, after the last Series Competition concludes on or about **June 15th**.

- Qualifying skater registration deadline will be **June 17th at 4:59pm ET**
- The committee will attempt to fill any qualifying spots that remain open following the June 17th registration deadline, by sending subsequent email invitations to those skater(s) next in line to qualify.
- New this year: the entry fee includes the full experience for the weekend: Excel Free Skate Final Competition, Finalist Camp, Competitors' Party and Team USA & Finalist Exhibition.

IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING IJS EVENTS:

The 2022 National Excel Festival and Final will continue to use the same calling specifications, guidelines and scoring as have been used throughout the 2022 Excel Series. Thus, all IJS events will still use ISU Communication No. 2253 (Single & Pair Skating Scale of Values) and ISU Communication No. 2334 (Levels of Difficulty and Guidelines for marking Grade of Execution in Single and Pair Skating), as well as the Excel Program Technical Information handbook for the 2022 season. ISU communication No. 2474 and No. 2475 will NOT be used at the 2022 Excel National Festival and Final. In addition, any other changes adopted at the ISU Congress, will NOT be in effect.
