Grade of Execution is a skating term and is a judge’s way of rewarding superb skating by determining how well skaters execute a technical element. It was chosen as the name of the Worlds 2025/Castle Island beer because the Worlds event brings together the best skaters across the globe competing for the title of world champion and Castle Island is one of the region’s best beers.

The Worlds 2025/Castle Island Brewing’s *Grade of Execution* is a Munich-style Helles, a pale lager beer originating in Germany. Light in flavor but with a medium body and a hint of fresh flowers in the nose, Grade of Execution is sure to be a crowd-pleaser for beer drinkers of all palates.
